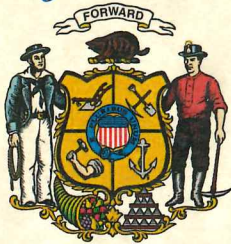

WHEREAS; the good health and well-being of the women of Wisconsin are enhanced as a direct result of efforts to spread awareness about gynecologic cancer; and

WHEREAS; the citizens of Wisconsin can work together to increase research into understanding the causes, to find effective screening and prevention strategies, and to develop improved therapies for gynecologic cancers; and

WHEREAS; families and advocates of gynecologic cancer victims play a valuable role in helping our medical community to advance the fight against these diseases;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,

throughout the State of Wisconsin and I commend this observance to all of our citizens.


